## DAY 1- Port Blair City Tour

On arrival at Port Blair airport, our representative will receive and escort you to the hotel. After check-in at the hotel and some rest, we will proceed to Corbyn's Cove Beach & Cellular Jail. In the evening enjoy the enthralling Light and Sound Show at Cellular Jail where the saga of the freedom struggle brought is brought alive. Night stay at Port Blair.

- **CORBYN'S COVE BEACH**- The coconut-palm fringed beach, 7 kilometers away town is ideal for swimming and sun-basking. Facilities like hotel, restaurant, bar, changing room, adventure water-sports are available here. Historical remains like Japanese Bunkers can be seen on the way to this beach. The Snake Island situated just across the beach is popular for scuba diving. The Restaurant & Beer Bar run by Tourism department provides delightful cuisine at reasonable rates in a soothing ambiance on the beach.



- **CELLULAR JAIL** –The Cellular jail, declared a National Memorial, is located at Port Blair which had stood as a mute witness to the most brutal and barbaric atrocities meted out to national freedom fighters, who were incarcerated in this jail. The jail, completed in the year 1906 acquired the name 'Cellular' because it was entirely made up of individual cells for solitary confinement. It originally was seven- block structure with three stories and a central tower acting as its fulcrum comprising of honeycomb like corridors. This jail, now a place of pilgrimage for all freedom-loving people draws everyone down memory lane to the years of freedom struggle. Jail Museum opens from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon and from 1:30 pm to 4:45 pm. Overnight Stay at Port Blair.
- **LIGHT AND SOUND SHOW:-**The Sound and Light show in the Cellular Jail narrates the saga of the Indian freedom struggle, brought alive through sound and light effect of the brutal and barbaric atrocities piled on the freedom fighters deported to these islands and incarcerated in the small cells of this jail. This show is very popular among the tourists visiting these islands.

## DAY2- Port Blair Swaraj Dweep Island (Radhanagar beach Departure)

Transfer to Swaraj Dweep (Havelock Island) by Cruise. On arrival, our representative will receive from Havelock jetty and escort you to check-in to the selected hotel. After little rest, proceed for the world's most renowned beach; Radhanagar Beach. The Island also has the biggest concentration of breath-taking diving and snorkelingsites, thus acting as a paradise to marine world explorers. Overnight stay at Havelock. • **SWARAJ DWEEP (HAVELOCK ISLAND)**:-The Island (often just called Havelock) is one of the most beautifuland largest islands of Ritchie's Archipelago and is a placid heaven like no other. Situated 57 kmnorth east of the South Andaman with an area of 92 Sq. Kms she offers a breath taking trail of natureexpeditions. The island is primarily populated by Bengali settlers. This picturesque Island with beautiful sandy beaches and lush green forest is also rated as the seventh most beautiful island in the world. The Island also has the biggest concentration of breath taking diving and snorkeling sites thus acting as a paradise to marine world explores

- **Radhanagar Beach** (or Beach No. 7) is the jewel in the crown of Havelock Island. Located on the western side of the island, it stands away from the cluster. The glorious white sand beach shot to global fame when Time magazine (in 2004) rated it as the finest in Asia. With lush tropical forest rising on a hill to one side, the draw of this white sand beach has steadily grown in the legion of avid beach buffs. A wide beach that runs over a few kilometers, Radhanagar is simply stunning. It lends itself to a variety of activities.
- **NOTE:** This day you'll be travelling by an early morning ferry. You may carry packed breakfast from your hotel asthe same will not be included at Havelock today. Ferry timings will be mentioned in the tickets provided to you.Please report minimum 45 minutes prior to departure timings with a valid photo id card. Ferry operation is purelysubjected to weather condition and government clearance. • Alcohol cannot be carried on-board the ferry. BeachNo 7 is closed for guests after sunset. • Guest cannot swim in the water after sunset



## DAY3- Havelock – Elephant Beach

After breakfast Tour of Elephanta Beach. Overnight stay at Havelock.

- **Elephanta Beach:** Elephanta Beach is one of the most beautiful places in Havelock Island which is famous for its clear water and variety of live corals & colorful fishes. One can do several other water sports activities like Glass Bottom, Snorkeling, Banana Ride, Sofa Ride etc. After breakfast proceed to Elephant Beach (All water sports on Supplement Cost) in a sharing fiber speed boat, this beach offers snorkelers calm blue shallow waters and is the perfect spot for beginner snorkelers. It's also a great place to just spend time lazing on the beach. The beach is very scenic with fallen trees and white sand giving the photographer some beautiful pictures to take back home.
- **Note-** This cost is inclusive of hotel-harbour transfers, boat charges, floating device and equipment's. This trip can be change to light house due to change in boat operation/ weather conditions or administrative reasons. • Guest cannot swim in the water after sunset. • Cars are limited on Havelock Island (Swaraj Dweep) and hence guests are requested to kindly adhere to the timelines as shared by the tour manager. • The boats to Elephant Beach are managed by a boat association who need individual guest consent forms after which boats are allotted based on rotation and sharing basis. Due to limited boats, guest may have to wait until their boat is allotted and please note that we have no control over the wait time. Alcohol is strictly prohibited on Elephant Beach.

## DAY4- Swaraj Dweep Havelock Island – Shaheed Dweep Neil Island

At morning have your breakfast in the hotel after that our representative will help you to board the Cruise which will sail to the Shaheed Dweep (Neil Island). On arrival at Neil Island, our representative will receive and escort you to check-in to the resort/hotel. Neil Island occupies an area of 18.9 square kilometres (7.3 Square Miles). The island is located 40 kilometres (25 miles) east of Port Blair. The breath taking view of sea and the lush greenery in the island is really rejuvenating and enjoyable for enthusiastic travellers. Return to hotel. Stay Overnight at Neil Island.

- **BHARATPUR BEACH:** – The Bharatpur Beach is a beach of a low tide located just half a kilometre from the jetty, considered to be the best beach in the Neil Island. The calm, tranquil and picturesque beach is also popular with various water activities like swimming, snorkeling and scuba diving.



- **LAXMANPUR BEACH:** – Laxmanpur Beach is a picturesque waterfront, covering a long stretch of area of Laxmanpur Village of Neil Island. The sea is shallow and calm, making it perfect for swimming and snorkeling. The serene beach offers a stunning panorama, especially the sun sets in the horizon.

- **NATURAL BRIDGE:** – Neil Island is famous for its naturally shaped- like rock also known as the Howrah Bridge. It has two living natural corals formed just like a bridge. The rock formation was called by the Bengalis who settled in the island in the early days and they refer it as the Rabindra Setu and later called it the Howrah Bridge. It is best seen during low tide.



## DAY5 – Return to Port Blair from Havelock Island Chidiyatapu

Morning transfer to Neil Island Jetty to take the return ferry to Port Blair as per ferry timing. Upon return from Neill Island, transfer to Hotel. Chidiya Tapu sightseeing. Overnight stay in Port Blair.

- **Chidiya Tapu** (Bird Island) (25 kms From Port Blair): Chidiya Tapu is the southernmost tip of South Andaman. The lush green Mangroves, forest cover with numerous chirping birds and the sylvan sands and Munda Pahar beaches makes it an ideal picnic site. The forest guest houses situated on top of the hillock provided a fabulous view of the isolated islands submerged corals and the breath taking sunsets. It is an ideal picnic site, with its lush green mangroves, picturesque beach and creeks and excellent fishing. True to its name, there is indeed a profusion of tropical birds.
- **NOTE:** Ferry timings will be mentioned in the tickets provided to you. Please report minimum 45 minutes prior to departure timings with a valid photo id card. Ferry operation is purely subjected to weather condition. • Do note that all Havelock Island & Neil Island hotels have an early morning check-out time and late check-out is provided at the discretion of the hotel management and subject to availability and Payment.





## DAY 6 – Port Blair to Ross Island – City Tour

After Breakfast you will be escorted to Andaman Water Sports Complex to catch a ferry/ Boat which will be your mate for the entire excursion to Ross Island. Thereafter Visit 03 Points which Includes Anthropological Museum, Samudrika Museum and Chatham Shaw Mills.

- **ROSS ISLAND** It was the Capital of Port Blair during British and Japanese regime, prior to India's Independence. It was named after Sir Daniel Ross a marine surveyor. It was nick named "The Paris of the East". It is now under the supervision of the Indian Navy. This island is an ideal destination for nature walk amidst sylvan surroundings with deer's, peacocks and exotic birds.
- **The Chatham Saw Mill:** Chatham Saw Mill is one of Asia's oldest and the largest sawmills. Built in a small Island and is connected to Port Blair by a Bridge. It is a store house, featuring rare species of timber (such as Kokko, Chulgam, Marblewood Padauk and Satinwood). The Island has the second largest wharf of these islands, where Island – mainland ships can berth

## DAY7- Wandoor Beach - Departure

After Breakfast proceed to Wandoor Beach, 30kms ride from Port Blair city through the Tsunami affected area, once used to be paddy land now fully covered with water resembles like a lake, one can have a glimpse of migrated wet land birds, now become an attraction for birds watchers. Drop at Airport. Return home with memories of a wonderful holiday. End of Tour
